



**Bridal Crochet Fingerless Gloves – Classic Fan Stitch Lace**  
Original Pattern Written by Jayda InStitches 2015 – Happy Crafting!

**Materials**

Yarn – 100 g fingering or baby weight yarn  
Hook – 5.50 mm (I/9) or SIZE TO FIT (see notes)  
Scissors  
Yarn needle  
Buttons, bows or other decorations (optional)

**Stitch Legend**

r – row  
st(s) – stitch(es)  
ch(s) – chain(s)  
sl st – slip stitch  
sc – single crochet  
dc – double crochet

**Stitch Legend**

**Fan** – a Fan is 5 dc worked into a single stitch (or space)

**Notes**

- glove is worked in the round, but you must join each row with a slip stitch to finish it
- gloves are reversible, there is no left or right
- pattern is based on a multiple of 8 stitches; if you change your hook size and a length of 24 chains is still too small to fit around your wrist, downsize your hook (no smaller than 4.25mm) and use the next multiple of 8 (32, 40, etc.) The pattern will be **the same** you just have to adjust the numbers at the end of each row to match your beginning stitch count
- number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses

**Pattern – Make 2**

Ch 24, join with a sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> ch to create circle

**R1:** ch 4, dc in the same st as joining, skip 3 sts, \*5 dc in the next st, skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st, skip 3 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* across. Join with a sl st in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the Ch 4.

**R2:** sl st into next ch 1 space, ch 3, 4 dc in the same ch 1 space, \*skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st, skip 3 sts, fan in the next ch-1 space\*. Repeat from \* to \* around, end with a sl st in the top of the Ch 3.

**R3:** sl st across the next 2 sts, ch 4, dc in the same st, \*fan in the next ch-1 space, skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st, skip 3 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* around. Join with a sl st in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the Ch 4.

**R4:** repeat Row 2

**R5:** ch 3, dc in the same st as joining, dc in the next 2 sts, \*2 dc in the next st, dc in the next 2 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* around. (32) Join with a sl st to the top of the Ch 3

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**R6:** ch 4, dc in the same st as joining, skip 3 sts, 5 dc in the next st, \*skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st, skip 3 sts, 5 dc in the next st\*. Repeat from \* to \*. (32) Join with a sl st to the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of the Ch 4.

**R7 Thumbhole row:** sl st into the ch-1 space, ch 3, 4 dc in the same space, skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st, skip 3 sts, Fan into the next ch-1 space, ch 3, skip 7 sts, Fan into the next ch-1 space, skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st, \*skip 3 sts, fan in the next ch-1 space, skip 3 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in the next st\*. Repeat from \* to \* around. (32)

**R8:** repeat Row 3

**R9:** repeat Row 2

**R10:** repeat Row 3.

**R11:** ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in each st around (32). Join with a sl st and fasten off. Weave in end.

**Finishing Row:** make a slip knot and join yarn with a sc along bottom foundation chain row. Sc in each st around. (24) Sl st to close row, fasten off and weave in end.

Sew buttons, bows or any other decoration you may wish to a single stitch in the solid double crochet row. Try on your gloves (remember to make one a left and the other a right!) before deciding where you will permanently place your decorations!
