



Crochet Cherries Applique

Pattern Designed and Written by Jayda InStitches 2015 – Happy Crafting!

Materials

Yarn: scrap amounts of any yarn in red and brown

Hook: 4.25mm / (G/6) / UK 7

Scissors, Yarn needle

Stitch Legend

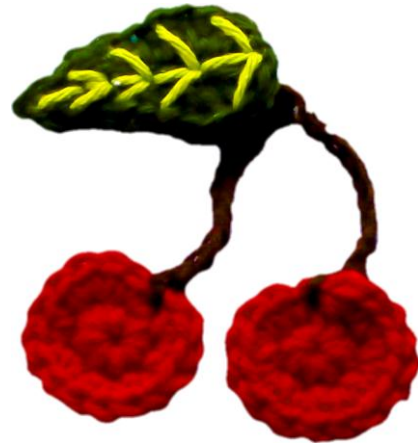
r – row

ch – chain

st(s) – stitch(es)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet



Notes

- Be sure to cinch your cinch circles tightly shut so there is no ‘gap’ in the middle of your Cherries!
- When sewing your Cherries onto stretchy fabric, be sure to keep your stitches a little looser than you might otherwise, this will help keep the fabric from buckling or pulling

Pattern

Cherries – Make 2 in red

R1: make a cinch circle, 8 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut (8) (do not join with a sl st)

R2: 2 sc into each st around (16). Sl st into the next st to close row. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Stem – Use brown

Make a slip knot and join brown yarn to the first Cherry with a slip stitch in space just beneath the slip stitch at the end of Row 2. Ch 11.

Sl st into the 2nd ch from the hook. Ch 10.

Sl st into the space just beneath the slip stitch at the end of Row 2 on the second Cherry. Fasten off and weave in ends.
