



## **Chevron Stitch Crochet Blanket**

Free Pattern Written by Jayda InStitches 2016 – Happy Crafting!

### **Materials**

Yarn: Acrylic, Cotton or Wool in Worsted Weight (size 4, 4 ply) – approximately 2000 grams for a blanket measuring 137 cm x 168 cm (54" x 66")

Hook: 5.50m / (I / 9)

Scissors, Yarn Needle

### **Stitch Legend**

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

dc – double crochet

dc3tog – double crochet 3 stitches together



### **Notes**

- Foundation Chain Row use any multiple of 14 plus 4
- The chain 3 at the beginning of each row counts as a double crochet
- All “Peaks” (or 3 dc in the same st) should be perfectly in line with the Peaks of the previous rows
- All “Valleys” (or dc3tog) should be perfectly in line with the Valleys of the previous rows
- Each row begins with half a Peak (ch 3 + 1 dc) and ends with half a Peak (2 dc)

### **Pattern**

**Chain a Foundation Row # that is ANY multiple of 14, then add 4 extra chains. (i.e.  $126 + 4 = 130$ )**

**R1:** dc into the 4<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook, \*dc into each of the next 5 sts, dc3tog, dc into the next 5 sts, 3 dc into the next st\*. Repeat from \* to \* across ending 2 dc in the last st. Ch 3, turn

**R2:** dc in the same st as ch 3, \*dc in each of the next 5 sts, dc3tog, dc in each of the next 5 sts, 3 dc into the next st\*. Repeat from \* to \* across ending 2 dc in the last st (this will be the top of the ch-3 from the previous row). Ch 3, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until blanket is desired length! Fasten off and weave in all ends.
