



Moss Stitch Dishcloth

Pattern Written by Jayda InStitches 2015 – Happy Crafting!

Materials

Yarn: cotton yarn, 4 ply, worsted weight, 30 g

Hook: 4.50 mm or 5.00 mm

Yarn Needle

Scissors

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet



Notes

- Number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses
- You can begin the Moss Stitch directly into your foundation row if you're comfortable identifying your chains, otherwise, work Row 1 the way it is written.
- This pattern is based on an even stitch count, so if you wish to make your dishcloth larger or smaller, change your foundation chains accordingly (even number plus 1 for turning)

Pattern

Ch 21

R1: sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across (20). Ch 1, turn

R2: sc in the first st, *ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in the next st*. Repeat from * to * ending row with a sc in the 2nd last st and a sc in the last st. (20). Ch 1, turn

R3 – R20: Repeat Row 2. (20).

Border Row 1: ch 1, working down the first raw edge, sc into the end of each row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the corner st, sc across the bottom of the foundation row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next corner, work a sc into the end of each row up the other raw edge, (sc, ch 2, sc) into the next corner, sc across the top of Row 20 and end with sc, ch 2 in the last st and sl st into the first sc of this row. As long as your border looks even, a stitch count isn't really important!

Border Row 2: Ch 1, sc in the same st as joining, sc in each st down the first side, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the ch-2 corner space from the previous row. Sc across the bottom row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next ch-2 corner space. Sc up the next side, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the next ch-2 corner space. Sc across the top of your dishcloth, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the last ch-2 space and sl st into the top of the first sc of this row. Do not fasten off.

If you wish to make the border bigger, repeat Border Row 2 as many times as you like.

Hanger

From the corner, ch 15, sl st into the ch-2 corner space. Ch 1, sc into each of the 15 chs and sl st back into the corner space. Fasten off and weave in ends.
