



Crochet Egg Applique Pattern

Pattern by Jayda InStitches 2017 – Happy Crafting!

Materials

Yarn: worsted OR baby weight (size 4 or 3), small amount any colour

Hook: 4.25 mm / (G / 6) / UK 7

Scissors, Yarn Needle

Optional: beads, ribbon, floss or scrap yarn for embellishment

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet



Notes (Read these before you start!)

- The number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses.
- The “False” stitch is the stitch that appears at the base of a chain used to begin a row.

Pattern

Ch 5

R1: sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in the next 2 chs, 3 sc in the last ch, (working up the underside of the foundation chain row) sc in the next 2 chs, 2 sc in the last ch, join with a sl st to the first sc (10). Ch 1, do not turn

R2: 2 sc in the same st as joining, sc, hdc, 2 hdc in each of the next 4 sts, hdc, sc, 2 sc in each of the last 2 sts (this includes the “False” st), join with a sl st to the top of the first sc (18). Ch 1, do not turn

R3: 2 sc in the same st as joining, sc in the next 3 sts, hdc, (2 hdc, hdc) 4 times, sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st, sc, join with a sl st to the first sc (24). *For smaller Egg, Fasten off. For larger Egg, continue onto Row 4. Ch 1, do not turn

R4: 2 sc in the same st as joining, sc in the next 5 sts, hdc, (2 hdc, hdc in the next 2 sts) 3 times, hdc, sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st, sc, 2 sc in the last st (30). Fasten off.

If you are sewing this applique onto a knit or crochet project, leave a long tail after fastening off for sewing.

If you are using the Eggs in a bunting, cut a short tail for fastening off and weave in all ends.

Embellish as desired!
