

Heart Throw Cushion Crochet Pattern

Original Pattern Written by Jayda InStitches 2016 – Happy Crafting!

Materials

Yarn: 4 ply (size 4) cotton, acrylic or wool, 80 g

Hook: 5.50 mm / (I / 9)

Scissors, Yarn Needle, Stuffing!

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

sc3tog – single crochet 3 stitches together

hdc – half double crochet stitch

hdc2tog – half double crochet 2 stitches together



Notes

- The number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses
- Ch-2 at the beginning of each row DOES NOT COUNT as a hdc
- Keep a rough tally of the sc you work in the border row of the first side and try and work the same number on the second side. This makes sewing them together easier and there are fewer areas to ‘cheat’.

Pattern

Heart – Make 2 – Chain 3 to begin.

R1: 3 hdc into the 3rd ch from the hook. (3) Ch 2, turn

R2: 2 hdc in the first st, hdc across to last st, 2 hdc in last st (5). Ch 2, turn

R3 – R13: Repeat Row 2. You will have 27 stitches at the end of Row 13.

Heart Left Side R14: hdc into each of the next 13 sts. (13) Ch 2, turn

R15: hdc2tog, hdc across to last 2 sts, hdc2tog. (11)

R16 – 18: repeat Row 15. You will have 5 sts at the end of Row 18. Fasten off.

Heart Right Side R14: Join yarn with a sl st on the opposite side of year, ch 2, hdc in each of the next 13 sts. Ch 2, turn.

R15 – R18: Repeat Rows 15 through to 18. DO NOT FASTEN OFF. Ch 1, do not turn.

Border Row: sc down the raw edge of the first side (approximately 24 to 26 sc), work 3 sc into the bottom point (foundation ch), sc up raw edge of the next side (same number of sc as the other side), 2 sc in the first st of the 18th row (right side), sc across the top of the Right Side, 2 sc in the last st of the 18th Row (right side), sc down the short raw edge (approximately 7 sc), sc3tog across the middle sts (one will be completely unworked, the other two will have the stitches in them), sc up the other raw short edge (approximately 7 sc) work 2 sc in the first st of the 18th Row (left side), sc across the top of the Left Side, work 2 sc in the last st (left side) and join with a sl to to the first sc of the Border Row. Fasten off and weave in ends. On your second heart, you can leave a LONG tail for sewing the two sides together when you fasten off.

Match the two sides together and begin sewing through both sets of stitches around. Leave space to stuff the Heart and then sew the rest of the pillow closed. Fasten off and weave in your ends!
