



### **Kitty Cup Cozy Pattern**

#### **Materials**

Yarn: Cotton, worsted weight (size 4) preferred colour ~10 g

Hook: 4.25mm / (G / 6) / UK 7

Scissors, Yarn Needle

Embroidery Floss & Needle, Buttons or Beads

#### **Stitch Legend**

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc- half double crochet



#### **Notes**

- This pattern is worked in the round, do not join rows with a slip stitch
- Number of stitches you should have will appear at the end of each row in parentheses
- If you have the mug handy, hold your foundation chain row around the narrow middle part of the mug to double check the sizing. If it's too short to reach around, add 1 or 2 chains, if there's overlap, remove 1 or 2 chains. Adjust stitch count in pattern accordingly.
- Pattern can be made 1 row shorter for a cold drink cozy!

#### **Pattern**

Ch 34, be careful not to twist your chain row, sc directly into your first ch

**R1:** sc in each ch around (34). Do not join with a sl st continue into first st of R1.

**R2 – R8:** sc in each st around (34). At the end of R8, sl st into the next st and fasten off. Weave in all ends.

#### **Ears**

Fold cozy in half so that the beginning/end of your rows is in the middle, this will be the back of your cozy. Flip it around so that you're looking at the front. Find the middle stitch along the top of your cozy, count 4 stitches to the right and join your yarn with a slip stitch to this stitch.

**Ear 1:** ch 4, sl st into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, sc into the next st, hdc into the next st. Skip the st next to where you joined your yarn and sl st into the next st.

Sl st into the next 4 sts.

**Ear 2:** Repeat Ear 1. Fasten off and weave in your ends.

Sew buttons into place for Eyes. With embroidery floss and needle, embroider a simple nose and mouth over a stitch in between the two eyes. Knot and weave in all ends.
