



Mini Evergreen/Christmas Tree Pillow – Crochet Pattern
Original Pattern Written by Jayda InStitches 2016 – Happy Crafting!

Materials

Yarn – 75 g acrylic worsted weight green holiday yarn (size 4), small amount of brown
Hook – 5.0mm (H / 8) OR 5.50 mm (I/9)
Scissors, Yarn needle, Stuffing,
Optional: Beads, Buttons, Ribbon etc.

Stitch Legend

r – row
st(s) – stitch(es)
ch(s) – chain(s)
sl st – slip stitch
sc – single crochet
hdc – half double crochet



Notes

- number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses

Pattern – Make 2

With green, ch 5

R1: hdc in 2nd ch from the hook and in each across (4). Ch 1, turn

R2: 2 hdc in the first st, hdc across to the last st, 2 hdc in the last st (6). Ch 1, turn

R3: hdc in eac st across (6). Ch 1, turn

R4: repeat Row 2 (8)

R5: repeat Row 3 (8)

R6 – R21: Continue to repeat rows 2 & 3. At the end of Row 21 you will have 24 sts.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Trunk

R22: Join brown with a sl st in the 10th st of Row 21. Ch 1, hdc in the same st as joining.
Hdc in the next 5 sts (6). Ch 1, turn

R23: hdc in each st across (6). Ch 1, turn

R24: sc in each st across. Fasten off and weave in ends.

- If you are decorating your Tree, do this before sewing the Tree together. For hints and tips on decorating your Tree, see our Ugly Christmas Sweater Tree Applique video on our YouTube Channel!
- Place Trees together and pin.
- With green yarn and yarn needle, begin on lower right where Tree meets Trunk and sew around Tree to bottom left tree corner.
- Stuff the Tree
- Sew up the bottom of the Tree. Fasten off green
- With brown yarn, sew around 2 sides of the Trunk.
- Stuff the Trunk
- Finish sewing up Trunk, fasten off and weave in ends.
