



Soap Saver Scrubbie Pattern

Materials

Yarn: cotton, worsted weight (size 4) yarn, approximately 30 grams

Hook: 4.25 mm / (G/6) / UK 7

Scissors, Yarn Needle

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet



Notes & Pattern Tricks!

- The number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses

Pattern

Bag

Ch 11

R1: 3 sc into the 2nd ch from the hook, sc in the next 8 chs, 3 sc into the last ch (turn your work, you are now working up the other side of the foundation chain row), sc into the next 8 sts, join with a sl st to the top of the first sc. (22) Ch 1, do not turn

R2 – R16: sc in the same st as joining, sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the top of the first sc (not the ch-1!). (22) Ch 1, do not turn.

R17(Drawstring Hole Row): sc in the same st as joining, *ch 2, skip 2 sts, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around, sl st to the top of the first sc. (22) Ch 1, do not turn.

R18(finishing row): sc into the same st as joining, *2 sc into the next ch-2 space, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around, sl st to the top of the first sc (22). Fasten off and weave in ends.

Drawstring

Ch 40 – 45 (or however long you want your drawstring!). Fasten off.

Weave Drawstring through the ch-2 spaces. Drawstring should enter and exit through same space.
