



Sunburst Motif Coaster Crochet Pattern

Pattern Written by Jayda InStitches 2016 – Happy Crafting!

Materials

Yarn: Cotton, worsted weight (size 4) in 2 colours (2 80g skeins will make 4 Coasters)

Hook: 4.25mm / (G / 6) / UK 7

Scissors

Yarn Needle

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

2dccl – 2 double crochet cluster

3dccl – 3 double crochet cluster



Special Stitches

Cinch Circle - cross yarn to make a loop, pass hook through loop from front to back, hook yarn and bring it back through loop to pull up a loop on your hook, chain 1. This will make, and secure, the circle. Work all successive stitches into circle over top of the shorter tail. When finished the first row of stitches, pull the shorter tail to cinch the circle shut.

2 Double Crochet Cluster - yarn over and pull up a loop in the working st, yarn over and pull through the first 2 loops on hook, yarn over and pull up a loop in the same st, yarn over and pull through first 2 loops on hook. You will have 3 loops on your hook, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

3 Double Crochet Cluster – yarn over and pull up a loop in the working st, yarn over and pull through the first 2 loops on hook, (yarn over and pull up a look in the same st, yarn over and pull through the first 2 loops on hook) 2 more times. You will have four loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

Notes (Read these before you start!)

- number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses

Pattern

R1: make a cinch circle, ch 3 (ch-3 counts as a dc), 15 dc into circle, cinch shut, join with a sl st to the top of ch-3 (16)

R2: ch 3, work a 2dccl in the same st as ch-3 (counts as a 3dccl), ch 1. (3dccl, ch 1) in each st around. Join with a sl st to top middle of 2dccl. You will have 16 clusters and 16 ch-1 spaces. (32)

R3: sl st to next ch-1 space. Ch 2. (hdc, ch 3, hdc) into the next ch-1 space and in each ch-1 space around. End row with (hdc, ch 3) in same space as ch-2. Join with a sl st to the top of ch-2. You will have 16 V-shaped spaces. (80)

R4: (2sc, ch 3, 2sc) in each ch-3 space around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.
