



## “Among Us” Amigurumi Spaceman Plushie Crochet Pattern

Jayda InStitches 2020

### Materials

Yarn: super bulky size 6: ~ 70 g / 72 y in any colour, 12 y white for mask (optional: 2 y for mask edging)

Hook: 8.00 mm / US L or 11 / UK 0

Scissors, Yarn Needle, Stuffing

### Stitch Legend

r – row	st(s) – stitch(es)
ch(s) – chain(s)	sl st – slip stitch
sc – single crochet	hdc – half double crochet
sc2tog – single crochet 2 stitches together	

### Notes (Important! Read these before starting)

- the number of sts you have in each row will be in parentheses
- Amigurumi measures approx. 15 cm x 15 cm (6 x 6 inches)
- if you don't have super bulky yarn, hold 2 strands of size 4 medium weight yarn together throughout 😊

### Special Stitches

**Cinch Circle** – cross yarn to make a loop, pass hook through loop from front to back, hook yarn and bring it back through loop to pull up a loop on your hook, chain 1. This will make, and secure, the circle. Work all successive stitches into circle over top of the shorter tail. When finished the first row of stitches, pull the shorter tail to cinch the circle shut.

**Sc2tog** – pick up a loop in the next st, pick up a loop in the st immediately next to the first (you will have 3 loops on your hook) yarn over and pull back through all 3 loops.

### Pattern – begin with the Body (main colour)

**R1:** make a cinch circle, 8 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut, do not join (8)

**R2:** 2 sc in each st around (16) do not join

**R3:** \*2 sc into the next st, sc into the next st\*. Repeat from \* to \* 8 times total, do not join (24) sc in each of the next 3 sts, to even up the circle (this will not change your stitch count)

**R4 – R11:** sc in each st around, do not join rows (24). Do not fasten off

**Leg 1, R1:** sc in each of the next 6 sts, skip 12 sts, sc tightly into the next st (this will split the body into 2 halves for the Legs), sc into the last 5 sts (12). Pause and stuff the body.

**Leg 1, R2 – R4:** sc in each st around (12), do not join rows

**Leg 1, R5:** sc2tog around (6). Stuff Leg

**Leg 1, R6:** sl st around the post of each st until opening closes. Fasten off and leave a tail, if you have any gaps between stitches at the bottom of the foot, weave the tail around gently cinching the little gaps shut. Pull remainder of tail into body.

**Leg 2, R1:** make a slip knot with a long tail (leave tail outside body for use later), join yarn with a sc in the unused st immediately next to the edge of Leg 1. Sc in each of the next 11 sts, do not join row (12)

**Leg 2, R2:** reach across to sc into the first st of Row 1, make it a tight st to close in as much of the gap between Leg 1 and Leg 2 as possible. Sc in each st around (12).





**Leg 2, R3 – R6:** work as for Leg 1. Thread up the long tail left at the beginning of Leg 2 and weave it through the stitches around the gap to close it up. Pull remainder of tail into body.

### Mask – use lighter colour – CH 5

**R1:** 3 hdc into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, hdc into the next 2 chs, 5 hdc into the last ch (you are now working up the underside of the foundation chain row), hdc into the next 2 chs, 2 hdc into the last ch, join with a sl st to the top of the first hdc (14). Ch 1, do not turn (if you wish to add a row of a darker colour like grey or black to outline the edge of the mask, fasten off and make a slip knot with the new yarn, join it anywhere along the edge of R1 with a sc and continue with R2)

**R2:** sc in the same st as joining, sc in each st around (14), join with a sl st to the top of the first st and fasten off. Leave a LONG tail for sewing. Thread up tail in your yarn needle.

**Sew Mask** to middle front of body by using the top facing loops of the body and the edge of each st around Mask. You may wish to add a little stuffing half way through sewing. When finished sewing, make a small knot, weave the tail through a couple of stitches to pull the knot in close to Mask and then pull the remainder of the tail into the body.

### Backpack – use main colour

**R1:** make a cinch circle, 8 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut, do not join (8)

**R2:** \*3 sc into the next st, sc into the next st\*. Repeat from \* to \* 4 times total (16) do not join row.

**R3 & R4:** sc in each st around (16) do not join rows. Sl st into the next st and fasten off, leave a LONG tail for sewing. Thread up long tail in yarn needle. Pinch and pull the backpack into a “squarish” shape.

**Sew Backpack** to middle back of body using the same method as for Mask. Stuff backpack before you finish sewing 😊
