



Beachy Beaded Anklet

Crochet Pattern by Jayda InStitches 2020

Materials

Yarn: Size 10 crochet thread less than 10 yards

Hook: 2.75 mm / US B or 1 / UK 13

Scissors, Needle, Measuring Tape

Small Glass Beads

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(s)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

dc – double crochet



1. Measure your ankle's circumference
2. Thread beads onto your crochet thread before crocheting. For every inch of ankle circumference, use 4 beads. It's always better to have too many beads than too few!

Pattern

Chain a length, any multiple of 3, that fits securely around your ankle (i.e. 60, 69, 72 etc). Be sure that the first and last chain meet. Now chain 10 more....and off we go!

R1: sl st into the 8th ch from the hook to form a loop. Sl st into the next ch and ch 3 (counts as a dc), skip 1 ch, *(dc, slide up a bead, ch 1 around the bead, dc) into the same ch, skip 2 chs*. Repeat from * to * across ending with (dc, slide up a bead, ch 1 around the bead, dc) into the same ch, skip 1 ch, dc into the last ch.

Ties: ch 25, slide up a bead, sl st around the bead into the 2nd ch from the hook, sl st in each ch across and into the top of the last dc st. Sl st into the side of the dc st, sl st into the first foundation ch (the little short tail will still be attached to it). Ch 25, slide up a bead, sl st around the bead into the 2nd ch from the hook, sl st into each ch across. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Remove any unused beads and put them away 😊

Straighten ties by pulling on them, they will also smooth out with use.

Tie Anklet on by running one tie through the loop and knotting the 2 ties together.
