



Bob and Teddy Crochet Pattern

Materials

Yarn: **Bob** – acrylic, medium weight (size 4) in yellow (80 g), blue (50 g), black (20g) scrap amounts in white, grey, brown & green. **Teddy Bear** – acrylic, medium weight (size 4) in brown (75g)

Hook: 4.25 mm / (G/6) / UK 7

Scissors, Yarn Needle, Stitch Marker

2x12mm blue buttons, 2x 5 mm white buttons (for Teddy)

Sewing needle & thread, embroidery floss

Scrap of pink felt (for Teddy's tongue)

Stitch Legend

r – row

st(s) – stitch(es)

sp(s) – space(es)

ch(s) – chain(s)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

sc2tog – single crochet 2 stitches together

hdc – half double crochet



Special Stitches

Sc2tog: pull up a loop in the next st (as if you were going to single crochet), pull up a loop in the stitch next to that one (you will have 3 loops on your hook), yarn over hook and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

Cinch Circle: cross yarn to make a loop, pass hook through loop from front to back, hook yarn and bring it back through loop to pull up a loop on your hook, chain 1. This will make, and secure, the circle. Work all successive stitches into circle over top of the shorter tail. When finished the first row of stitches, pull the shorter tail to cinch the circle shut.

Notes

- The number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses
- Many pieces are worked in the round, do not join rows with a slip stitch – work the first stitch of the next row into the first stitch of the previous row.
- Bob will measure approximately 25 cm (10”) tall, Teddy approximately 10 cm (4”) tall
- When sewing or embroidering, leave a little bit of the thread outside of the Body, sew using the top loops of the sts on the Body and the whole st along the edge of the detail, and then bring your thread back out through the same place that you brought it in, knot the ends together and pull the tails back into the Body.

Pattern

Body – Begin with Yellow

R1: make a cinch circle, 8 sc into circle, cinch shut (8). Place stitch marker on first or last stitch of Row 1 and leave it there for reference



R2: 2 sc into each st around (16)

R3: 2 sc into the next st, sc into the next st*. Repeat to * around (24)

R4: 2 sc into the next st, sc into the next 2 sts*. Repeat to * around (32)

R5: 2 sc into the next st, sc into the next 3 sts*. Repeat to * around (40)

R6 – R19: sc in each st around (40). At the end of R19, even up stitches to align with the stitch marker (this does not change your stitch count). Sl st into the next st, and fasten off yellow.

R20: with blue yarn, make a slip knot and join yarn with a sc in the st immediately next to where you fastened off yellow. Sc in each st around (40). Do no join with a sl st.

R21 – R23: sc in each st around (40).

R24: sc2tog, sc into the next 3 sts*. Repeat to * around (32)

R25: sc2tog, sc into the next 2 sts*. Repeat to * around (24)

Stuff Bob!

R26 Divide for Legs: sc into the next 12 sts. Skip across to first stitch leaving the remaining 12 sts unworked, pull this stitch tightly to try and close the gap in the middle, continue sc into the first st

Leg 1 R27 – R28: sc in each st around (12). At the end of Row 28, fasten off blue and weave in end.

Leg 2 R26: join blue yarn with a sc in 13th st of Row 26. Sc in next 12 sts, skip back to first sc and continue sc in this st (pull last stitch of Row 26 tightly to try and close gap)

Leg 2 R27 – R28: sc in each st around (12). At the end of Row 28, fasten off blue and weave in end.

Stuff Legs and Bottom.

Feet – Make 2 in Black

R1: make a cinch circle, 6 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut (6) do not join with a sl st. Place a stitch marker on the first or last st of R1 and leave it there for reference.

R2: 2 sc into each st around (12)

R3 – R5: sc in each st around (12). At the end of row 5, even up stitches with the stitch marker.

Begin Heel R6: sc in the next 3 sts. (3) Ch 1, turn

R7: sc back across the next 4 sts. (4) Ch 1, turn

R8: sc back across the 4 sts and sc into the st from R5 immediately next to your 4th st. (5) Ch 1, turn

R9: sc back across the 5 sts and sc into the st from R5 immediately next to your 5th st. (6) Ch 1, turn

R10: sc back across the 6 sts and sc into the st from R5 immediately next to your 6th st. (7) Continue crocheting around the rest of R5. Heel made (12).

Continue sc in the round for 1 more row. Sl st into the next st and fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing Foot to Leg. Stuff Feet and sew to each Leg.

Overall Bib – Use Blue

Ch 14

R1: sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each across (13). Ch 1, turn

R2 – R4: sc in each st across (13). Ch 1, turn. At the end of Row 4, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing Bib into place. Weave in short end.

Sew Bib to top of Pants across middle front of Bob.

Overall Straps – Make 2 in Blue

Ch 24



R1: hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each across (23). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing Strap to Body.

Arms – Make 2 in Yellow

Ch 8

R1: sc into the first ch (creating a circle) and sc into each ch around (8). Continue working in the round, do not join with a sl st. Place a stitch marker on the first or last st of R1 for reference.

R2 – R12: sc in each st around (8). At the end of R12, even up stitches with the stitch marker, sl st into the next st and fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew Arm to Body. Weave in short end. The Arm will resemble a long, hollow tube.

Stuff the Arms.

Hands – Make 2 in Black

Begin with the Fingers – Make 3

R1: make a cinch circle, 4 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut (4). Do not join with a sl st

R2 & R3: sc in each st around. For the first 2 Fingers, at the end of R3, sl st into the next st and fasten off. Weave/tuck in ends. For the 3rd Finger, finish R3, do not fasten off and continue directly into R4.

Form Hand R4: sc into the next 2 sts, pick up the next Finger and sc into 2 of its sts, pick up the last Finger and sc around the entire finger, sc into the last 2 sts of the middle Finger and sc into the last 2 sts of the first Finger (12).

R5 & R6: sc in each st around (12).

R7: *sc2tog, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around (8).

R8: sc in each st around (8). Sl st into the next st, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing Hand to the end of the Arm.

Stuff the Hand. Sew the Hand to the foundation chain row end of the Arm.

Sew Arms to either side of Bob.

Sew the Overall Straps to Body beginning at top back of Pants, over the shoulders and to top corners of Bib, there should be a little overhang.

Sew a blue button onto the Strap where it overhangs on the front of the Bib (see picture). These buttons are for show and are not supposed to work ☺

Eyes (with Goggles)– Make 2: 1 with a Green Centre, 1 with a Brown Centre

R1: with blue or brown, make a cinch circle, 6 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut (6). Join with a sl st and fasten off.

R2: join white with a sc in any st. sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in each of the next 5 sts (12). Join with a sl st and fasten off white.

R3: join grey with a sc in any st, sc in same st as joining, sc in the next st *2 sc into the next st, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around (18). Join with a sl st and fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew Eye to Bob.

Goggle Strap – Make 1 in Black

Ch 51

R1: hdc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each across (50). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing strap around head.



Sew on the strap so that the ends meet on the front of the body. The strap may not completely meet in the middle of the front of the face, this is ok, the Goggles will cover it. Sew along one side and then the other of the strap to ensure it doesn't go anywhere!

Position the two Eyes in the very middle of the face evenly over top of the Strap so that the middles of the two Eyes are touching. Pin and sew into place. Embroider a simple smiling mouth centered below the Goggles (See picture).

Bob's Teddy Bear

Head - use Brown

R1: make a cinch circle, 8 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut (8). Place a stitch marker on first or last st of R1 and leave it there for reference.

R2: 2 sc into each st around (16)

R3: *2 sc into the next st, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around (24)

R4 - R7: sc in each st around (24). At the end of R7, even up your sts to be in line with the stitch marker (this does not change your stitch count).

R8: *sc2tog, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around (16). Sl st into the next st, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing Head to Body.

Stuff the Head

Body - use Brown

R1: make a cinch circle, 8 sc into circle, cinch tightly shut (8). Place a stitch marker on first or last st of R1 and leave it there for reference.

R2: 2 sc into each st around (16)

R3: *2 sc into the next st, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around (24)

R4 - R9: sc in each st around (24). At the end of R9, even up your sts to be in line with the stitch marker (this does not change your stitch count).

R10: *sc2tog, sc into the next st*. Repeat from * to * around (16)

Stuff the Body

Arms & Legs - Make 4

R1: make a cinch circle, 6 sc into circle, cinch shut (6)

R2: 2 sc into each st around (12)

R3 - R6: sc in each st around. At the end of R5, sc into the next st, sl st into the next st and fasten off.

Leave enough tail to sew Arm or Leg to Body. Stuff lightly.

Ears - Make 2

R1: make a cinch circle, ch 1 (you will have a circle with 2 chains), 10 hdc into circle, cinch shut (11) ch 1, turn

R2: sc in each st around, including ch2 from previous row (11). Fasten off and leave enough tail for sewing Ear to Head.

Sew Ears to either side of top of Head. Sew buttons onto face for eyes. Embroider a simple triangle Nose using black embroidery floss. Sew small "D" shaped piece of pink felt just under Nose for Tongue.
