

Crochet Christmas Light Appliqué Pattern

Materials

Yarn: acrylic, medium weight (size 4) approx. 9 g / 20 y in any colour, per Light, tiny amount of grey

Hook: 5.50 mm / US I or 9 / UK 5

Scissors, Yarn Needle

Stitch Legend

r - row

ch(s) - chain(s)

sp(s) - space(s)

st(s) - stitch(es)

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

sc2tog – single crochet 2 stitches together



Notes (Read these before you start!)

- The number of stitches you should have at the end of each row will appear in parentheses
- Christmas Light measures approximately 6.5 cm tall x 3 cm wide (2.5 x 1.5 inches)

Pattern – With Light Colour, CH 2

R1: sc into 2nd ch from the hook (1). Ch 1, turn

R2: 2 sc into the st (2). Ch 1, turn

R3: 2 sc into each st (4). Ch 1, turn

R4: 2 sc into the first st, sc into each of the next 2 sts, 2 sc into the last st (6). Ch 1, turn

R5 - R7: sc in each st across (6). Ch 1, turn

R8: sc2tog, sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog (4). Ch 1, turn

R9: sc2tog twice (2). Ch 1, do not turn, do not fasten off.

Edging

R1: sc in the edge of each of the 8 rows (below the last row), 3 sc into the bottom of the foundation ch, sc in the edge of each of the 8 rows up the other side to just below the last row, sl st into the top of the first st of Row 9 (19 sts, but stitch count doesn't really matter here!). Fasten off and weave in your ends.

Metal Base

R1: join grey with a sc in the first of the 2 middle stitches of Row 9. Sc into the next st (2). Ch 1, turn

R2: sc in each st (2). Ch 1, turn

R3: sc in each st (2). Fasten off and weave in ends.

Fun Ideas

- Make a Garland!
- Sew them to projects like blankets, sweaters, Christmas stockings & bags!
- If you're sewing them to a project, leave long yarn tails on both the light and the base for sewing



- Use them as gift toppers or present tags
- Add a little ribbon and they make cute Tree Ornaments too!
