



Little Christmas Wreath Applique Crochet Pattern

Jayda InStitches 2020 – Merry Christmas!

Materials

Yarn: any fiber, size 4 or 5 weight (medium, Aran or chunky/bulky): approx. 5 y per Wreath

Hook: 5.50 mm / US I or 9 / UK 5

Scissors, Yarn Needle

Beads, Buttons, Ribbon, Tiny Bells

Needle & Thread or Glue

Stitch Legend

r – row	st(s) – stitch(es)
ch(s) – chain(s)	sl st – slip stitch
sc – single crochet	dc – double crochet

Notes (Important! Read these before starting)

- The number of sts for each row will be in parentheses
- Little Wreath will measure approximately 6.5 cm (2.5 inches) across

Pattern – CH 12

Join with a sl st to the first ch to make a ring. Ch 1

R1: (sc, 2 dc, sc) into the same st as joining, *skip 1 ch, (sc, 2 dc, sc) into the next ch*. Repeat from * to * 5 times total (24 sts or 6 little bubbly “petals”). Join with a sl st to the first sc.

R2: sl st into each foundation chain around centre of Wreath (12). Fasten off. If you are using this Wreath as an applique, leave a long tail of yarn for sewing (approx. 20 cm or 10 inches)

R3 (optional) Snow: join white yarn with a sl st in the edge of a “petal”. Sc in each st along top edge of Wreath (see photo below). Sl st into the middle of the 4th “petal” and fasten off. Weave in ends.

Decorating Ideas

- Sew or glue little buttons, beads or bells into the middle of each “petal” (see photo below)
- Sew or glue on a simple bow tie (use ribbon or yarn)
- Add a little sparkle glue!
- Try sparkle “Holiday” yarn (see photo above)
- Add a simple string, fishing line or yarn tie to hang Wreath as a Tree Ornament or use as a gift tag
