



“Paper” Chain Bunting Crochet Pattern

Jayda InStitches 2020

Materials

Yarn: any fiber, size 3, 4 or 5 weight (DK, light, sport, medium, Aran or chunky/bulky): approx. 10y per Link

Hook: 5.50 mm / US I or 9 / UK 5

Scissors, Yarn Needle

Stitch Legend

r – row st(s) – stitch(es)

ch(s) – chain(s) sl st – slip stitch

dc – double crochet

Notes (Important! Read these before starting)

- The number of sts for each row will be in parentheses
- Each link will measure approx. 20 cm (10”) long x 3 cm (1.25”) wide with variance owing to yarn weight
- The Ch-2 counts as a dc. Always skip the first st of the row because it’s being “used” by the ch-2
- For the Seam, you can also leave a long tail and sew (rather than sl st) for an invisible seam

Pattern – FIRST LINK – CH 37

R1: dc in the 4th ch from the hook and in each ch across (34). Ch 2, turn

R2: dc in each st across, including the top of the ch-2 (34). Do not ch, do not turn

Seam: Bring short ends together and sl st into the top edge of the opposite side (see photo below, left). Sl st through a set of loops (a loop from each side - see photo below, right) down the short edge, (~4).

Fasten off and weave in ends (see photo bottom of page, left). Optional: Turn inside out.



ALL ADDITIONAL LINKS – CH 37

R1 & R2: Repeat Rows 1 & 2 of First Link.

Seam: Slip Link through last closed Link on Chain (see photo below right). Repeat Seam instructions for First Link.
