



## Totally Tunisian Calendar Blanket Border Crochet Pattern

Jayda InStitches 2022

### Materials

Yarn: size 4 medium weight acrylic: Row 1 ~29 y; Row 2 ~60 y (or 30 y per colour); Row 3 ~30 y

Hook: 5.50 mm / US I or 9 / UK 5

Scissors, Yarn Needle

### Stitch Legend

r – row	st(s) – stitch(es)
ch(s) – chain(s)	sl st – slip stitch
sc – single crochet	dc – double crochet

### Notes (Important! Read these before starting)

- This border can be worked over any number of stitches.
- This pattern includes instructions for both a 2-colour double crochet row (shown) and a 1-colour double crochet row (if preferred).
- If you need to cheat in or out a stitch, do it! This is a very flexible border and does not rely on specific stitch counts ❤️



### Pattern

**R1:** begin in the top right corner (right handed: top left for left handed) and join border colour with a sc in the ch-1 corner sp, (ch 2, sc) in the same sp, \*sc in each st across to next seam, sc in the top edge of the first square border, sc in the top of the seam join, sc in the top edge of the second square border\*. Repeat from \* to \* across to next Blanket corner. (sc, ch 2, sc) in the ch-1 corner sp. Continue with \* to \* repeat, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in the remaining 2 blanket corners. Join with a sl st to the first sc that began the row and fasten off.

**R2 Two-Colour Version:** Join Colour A with a sl st in the ch-2 corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc in the same sp. Drop Colour A, place a slip knot of Colour B on hook (counts as yarn over), dc each of the next 2 sts working over top of dropped Colour A. \*Drop Colour B, dc in each of the next 2 sts with Colour A, working over top of dropped Colour B. Drop Colour A, dc in each of the next 2 sts with Colour B, working over top of dropped Colour A\*. Repeat from \* to \* across top of blanket to second ch-2 corner sp, 3 dc in the corner sp, continue to repeat from \* to \* around, with 3 dc in the ch-2 corner sps. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3 that began the row. Fasten off both colours.

**R2 Single-Colour Version:** Join new colour with a sl st in the ch-2 corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc), 2 dc into the same sp, \*dc in each st across to next ch-2 corner, (3 dc) in the corner sp\*. Repeat from \* to \* around, join with a sl st to the top of the ch-3 that began the row. Fasten off.

**R3:** join original border colour with a sc in the middle of the 3 corner sts, (ch 2, sc) in the same st, \*sc in each st across to next corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in the middle of the 3 corner sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* around. Join with a sl st to the top of the first sc and fasten off.

Row 2 and Row 3 can be repeated as often as preferred for a larger border.
